<i>Aloha</i>	Hawaiian	Means affection, peace, compassion or mercy. Commonly used as a Hello greeting.	
<i>Bonjour</i>	French	Hello (or Good day all day until around "6:00 pm", then it becomes "Bonsoir")	chère amie (dear friend - feminine version)
<i>Salut</i>	French	Hi	chère amie (dear friend - feminine version)
<i>Ciao</i>	Italian	Used as both "Hello" and "Goodbye".	bella
<i>Hola</i>	Spanish	Hello	amigo (friend - male version but applicable generally too)

Word	Language	Description	Pairing sentiments
你好	Mandarin (China)	Pronounced as “ni hao”  Hello (or could also be used as “how are you”?)	
नमस्ते	Hindi (India)	Pronounced as “na-mas-te”  Hello (spoken with palms of hands joined together and a slight bow)
